Califordia Confributions to the Polish The following letter is self-explanatory : Panis, October 20, 1863. The Polish Committee in Paris to Mr. Lazord. President of the Polish Committee in San Fraucisco:

Ma. PRESIDENT .- The Polish Committee in Paris has received the som of \$2,600 transmitted by you in the name of the Committee of San Franelseo, for which amount we have sent a receipt. This new contribution proves the generous sympathy of the citizens of Sin Francisco for the Polich cause, and our Committee in renewing

their most sincere thanks to you, Mr. President, beg you at the same time, to b interpreter of 'eir sentments of craticale to your generous and patriotic fellow-citizens. At this time when our nation is outraged in her most sacred sentiments, and enflering the most horrible marty dom, the material and moral

aid which you give as secures an imperishable title to the gratitude of the Polish nation. Receive. Mr. President, the assurance of our highest consideration. J. ORDENZ. Member and Secretary of the Committee.

The whole amount remitted by the committee at San Francisco is \$8,000, a portion of which was contributed by the citizens of Nevada Territory and British Columbia. In addition, we learn that

the Polish Society of this city has remitted \$550 to the Committee at Paris, and that the members

contribute monthly for that purpose.
