



# Suits for Damages.

John Belkowski bas commenced suit in the Superior Court against the Pacific Oil and Lead Works to recover \$25,000 damages for personal injuries alleged to have been suspersonal injuries alleged to have been sustained by plaintiff while in the employ of defendants in June of last year. 
