SAN DIEGO, March 23.—(Regular Correspondence.) The first meeting of the San Diego County Tobacco Raising and Manufacturing association was held at Hotel Brewster last night, when J. Wade McDonald was chosen as president, Geo. Kroenert, vice-president, J. E. O'Brien secretary and treasurer and C. V. Engelmann general manager. This organization has been effected for the purpose of cultivating and manufacturing the Havana grade of tobacco and cigars, and to develop and encourage the industry. The industry has already gone beyond the experimental stages, and the product already on the market made from the tobacco leaf grown here has found favor with all who indulge in its uses. It is estimated that about twenty-five acres were planted to cigar tobacco during the past year, and at least 150 more will be planted this year. Mr. Engelmann, who is an expert in this line of business, says that in all tobacco raising countries it requires two and sometimes three years to properly cure the leaf so as to render it fit for manufacture into cigars, while in San Diego he finds that nine months accomplished the desired results. Here the roots thrive after the leaves are harvested and cultivation only is necessary to bring forth another crop.

There was considerable tobacco grown in Lake county a number of years ago, and it is said to have been of excellent quality.
