In 1940-41 over 1 million Polish citizens of Catholic, Jewish, Ukrainian and Belorussian ethnicities from eastern Poland were killed, repressed or deported to prisons, forced labour camps (GULAGS) and “special settlements” in Siberia, Kazakhstan and Soviet Asia.
