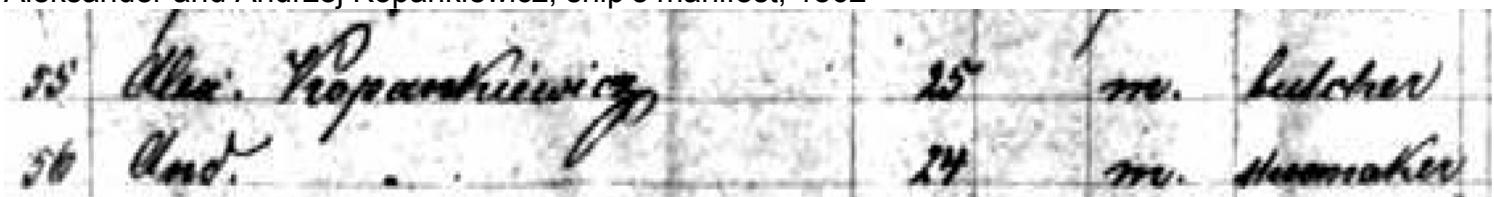

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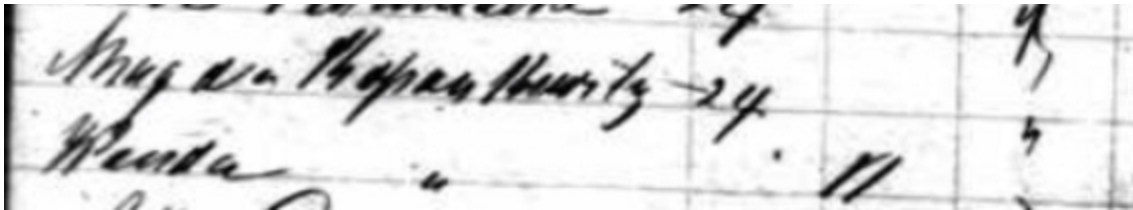

As group of the Polish Alliance, meets every third Sunday of each month. Officers—Captain C. Bielawski, President; Andrew Kopankiewicz, Vice-President; Ignatz Kolaska, Secretary and Librarian; Gustav Hellman, Treasurer.

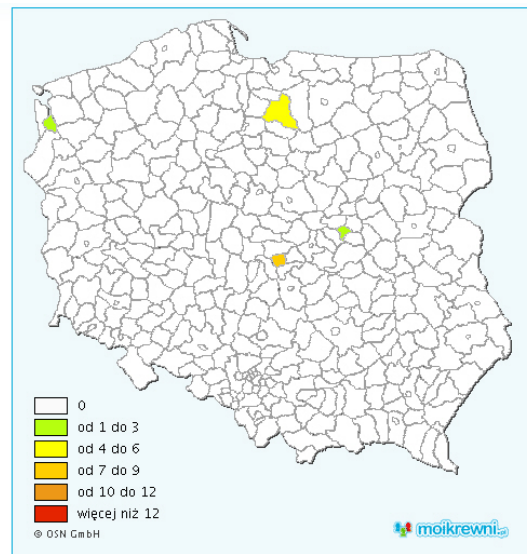
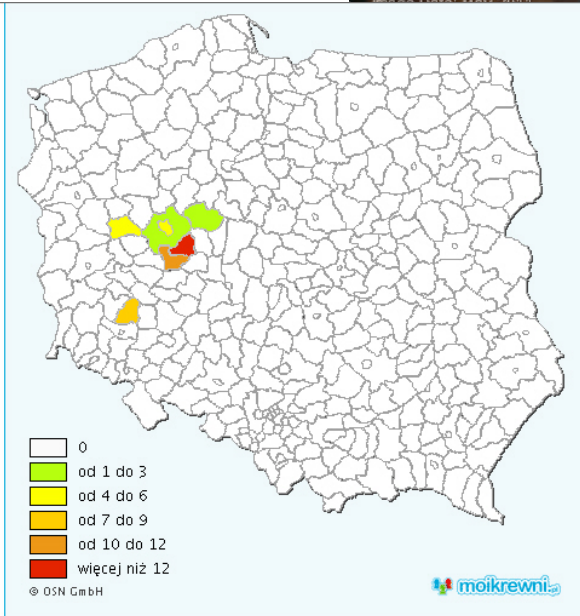
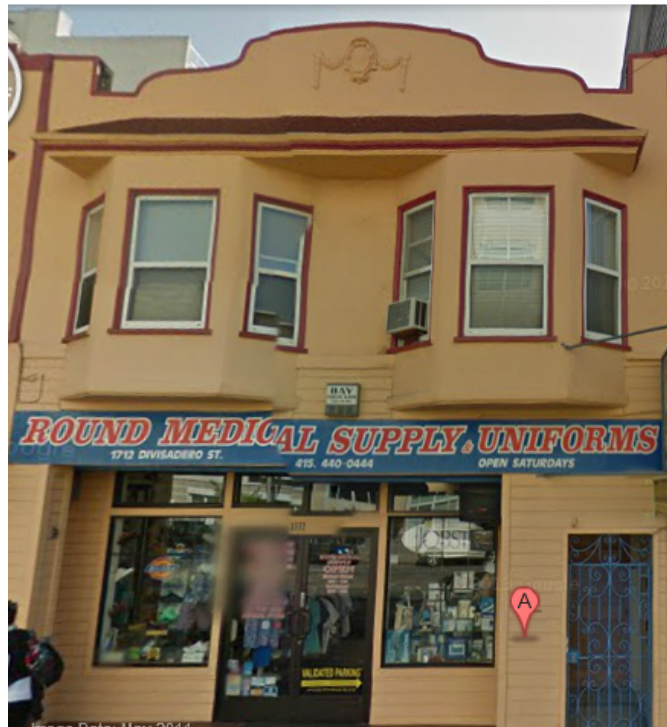
